1



Clean a large 3L plastic milk bottle.

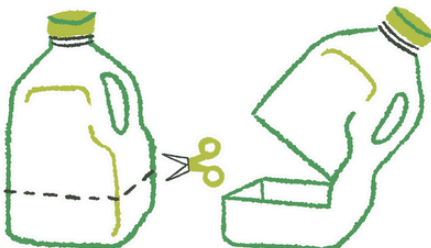

Poke about 9 holes, 5cm in diameter in the bottom with the tip of a glue gun, craft knife or scissors.

Make a cut in the bottle, about 10cm from the bottom, almost the whole way around the bottle, leaving enough to work as a hinge.

Add your seeds following the instructions on the packet. Swan plant seeds are brilliant.

Write the name of the seeds on the milk bottle lid, and replace the lid.

Hinge the top half of the bottle back into place and leave it in the sun, sprinkling with water if it dries out.

Your seeds have a mini greenhouse!
