

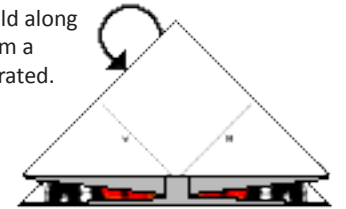
1. Print this out onto A4 paper. If printer warns you that the image is larger than what the printer can handle, choose "scale to fit".

2. Cut along solid lines to remove instructions and 1cm printer margin on left-hand side.

3. With printed side facing down fold in half along diagonal line to form triangle, unfold and fold in half along opposite diagonal line.

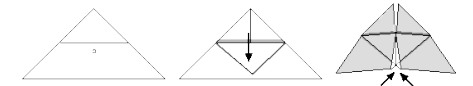
4. With printed side facing up, fold in half along horizontal line. Unfold again.

5. Carefully fold along creases to form a 'tent' as illustrated.



6. Fold the right tent corner up along line A, and fold the left tent corner up along line B.

7. Turn monarch over, printed side down. Fold down line C as illustrated below.



8. Pinch or crease in centre as illustrated above.

9. Fold in corners of wings to 'hide' white ends.

10. Add pipe-cleaner antennae (feelers).

10. Your monarch is ready to fly!
